Pet Group Purpose

The purpose of the Pet Group is to promote the well-being of the pets, pet owners and individuals interested in pets at Charlestown.



We are a self-governing organization that provides a valuable service to the Charlestown Community. We are led by a Steering Committee of resident Pet Building Representative volunteers who oversee the program.

The Registrar

Keeps an up to date list of pets and their owners coming from the Community Resources and Sales Offices.

Provides Pet Building Representatives with the name of all new pet owners who move into Charlestown in their area of responsibility.

Keeps and distributes an up to date list of veterinarians, groomers and caretakers in the Catonsville area.

The Pet Building Representatives

A Pet Building Representative is an individual who has volunteered to perform the following services for pets and pet owners in their building(s):

- *Greet all new pet owners who move into their building.

- *Encourage the pet owner to devise an emergency care plan for their pet, in case the owner becomes sick or is away.

- *Provide a point of contact for pet owners.
