MIXED RECYCLE

For Weekly PICKUPS

YES!

CLEAN – DRY – EMPTY – LABELS OK

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- ✓ Boxes – cereal, snack, shoe, clean pizza
- ✓ Cardboard packaging, **FLATTENED**
- ✓ Cartons – milk, juice, soup
- ✓ Catalogs, magazines, newspapers
- ✓ Paper sheets, rolled and waxed paper
- ✓ Paper egg cartons
- ✓ Tubes from paper towels and toilet paper

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Plastic containers

- ✓ Bottles and jars – caps reattached
- ✓ Clamshells & other plastic carry-outs
- ✓ Flower pots, frozen food trays
- ✓ Jugs – milk, juices, laundry
- ✓ Tubs – butter, cheese, yogurt

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- ✓ Aluminum beverage cans
- ✓ Aluminum foil, single-use aluminum pans
- ✓ Steel and tin food cans
- ✓ Pet food cans
- ✓ **EMPTY** aerosol cans

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- ✓ Food jars
- ✓ Soda and beer bottles
- ✓ Wine bottles, no caps or corks

MIXED RECYCLE - NO

NO FOOD – NO TRASH – NO PLASTIC BAGS

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NO Paper with plastic, wax, or foil coatings

NO Thermal paper – receipts, faxes

NO Shredded paper

NO Paper soiled with food –

Include these with your food scraps instead!



Paper napkins, paper towels

Torn up greasy pizza boxes

BPI certified food containers

Shredded paper

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NO Styrofoam™

NO Plastic without a triangle number

NO CD/DVDs or their cases

NO Plastic bags or packaging

Use Laundry Room Plastic Bag Bin

NO Plastic Utensils

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NO SCRAP METAL - Put in trash



- Pots, pans, utensils, metal hangers

- Lamps, small appliances, tools

NO ELECTRONICS - Save for Electronics Day



- Computers, printers, monitors, TVs

- Smart phones, electronic gadgets

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NO Drinking glasses, crystal, vases

NO Glass cookware

NO Light bulbs

NO Mirrors

PLASTIC BAGS & PACKAGING – YES

Place in laundry room containers

- ✓ **Retail plastic shopping bags**
- ✓ **Bubble wrap**
- ✓ **Deflated shipping “pillows”**
- ✓ **Plastic shipping envelopes**
- ✓ **Plastic protective bags**
- ✓ **Dry cleaning bags**
- ✓ **Newspaper sleeves**
- ✓ **Retail plastic bread and produce bags**
- ✓ **Plastic cereal box liners**
- ✓ **Plastic food storage bags and Zip Lock bags**

PLASTIC BAGS AND PACKAGING – NO

REUSE or put in your TRASH

- Cloth shopping bags
- Woven plastic shopping bags
- Compostable bags
 - *Use for your food scraps*
- Biodegradable bags
 - *Use as a trash bag*
- Candy and snack bags
- Frozen food bags
- Pet food bags
- Net or mesh bags
- Plastic food wrap
- Six-pack rings- cut before disposal
- Floral and other crinkly wrap
- Soil and fertilizer bags
- PPE – gloves, masks, etc.

METAL

Products containing copper, steel, brass, iron, and other common metals

- ☐ **Pots, pans, and other metal cookware**
- ☐ **Lamps**
- ☐ **Electric extension cords**
- ☐ **Cables (TV, stereo, USB)**
- ☐ **Small kitchen appliances (mixers, toasters, hot plates)**
- ☐ **Kitchen tools (knives, metal utensils/containers)**
- ☐ **Hand and power tools**
- ☐ **Sewing machines and equipment**
- ☐ **Hair dryers, steam irons**
- ☐ **Vacuum cleaners**

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If in working condition, consider donating to the Treasure Sale. If not, save for when dumpster is on site.

METAL – NO

Don't include items that are better to recycle elsewhere
