

# CHARLESTOWN RECYCLES

## Materials Accepted:

- Aluminum food and beverage containers, foil & pie tins
- Milk & Juice paper/ carton containers
- Tin & steel cans
- Clam shell containers (#5) polypropylene
- Glass, jar, food and beverage containers—brown, clear, or green
- All plastic containers with the symbol #1-7 narrow neck containers milk, water, detergent, shampoo and bleach ( bottles & caps left open)

\*\*All recyclable glass containers, tin & bi-metal, aluminum, aerosol cans must be cleaned, empty and contain less than 5% food content.

## Accepted Mixed Residential Paper:

- Newsprint, paperback and hardcover books (remove cover before recycling)
- Old corrugated cardboard
- Magazines
- \*Office paper
- Catalogs
- \* Mail with plastic windows
- Cereal boxes
- \* Envelopes
- Telephone books
- All paper must be clean, free of food debris and other contaminating material

-Tissues, paper towels or other paper that have been in contact with food is not acceptable.

## Materials “NOT” Accepted:

- Lead acid batteries
- Hazardous Material
- Plastic lids
- Ceramics
- Plastic wrap
- Microwave trays
- Plastic straws, utensils
- Porcelain
- Bakeware
- Medical Waste
- Glass cookware
- Food waste, film

- Styrofoam coffee & soup cups, salad containers from store including peanut packaging
- Mirrors, window or auto glass
- Plastic coat hangers
- Plastic unnumbered (catering/dining coffee cups black)
- Household items such as cooking pots, toasters, etc
- Light bulbs (CFL/Fluorescent only ) call Hskp or Maintenance for pick up
- Dry cell batteries (recycle containers in laundry rooms)

## Plastic bags are not acceptable:

**They can be recycled at your local food market or in special marked containers in the laundry rooms**
