Topics to be covered include Beethoven's early life, the Classical Era in music history, Beethoven's Early Period as a composer and pianist, his early sonatas, piano trios, and start of his symphonies, Beethoven's increasing deafness, the Heiligenstadt Treatment, the transformation of Beethoven to write his music in a new and unique style, and more.
