Then upload the dupe file you just created, by clicking the button on ARRL's form to the right.

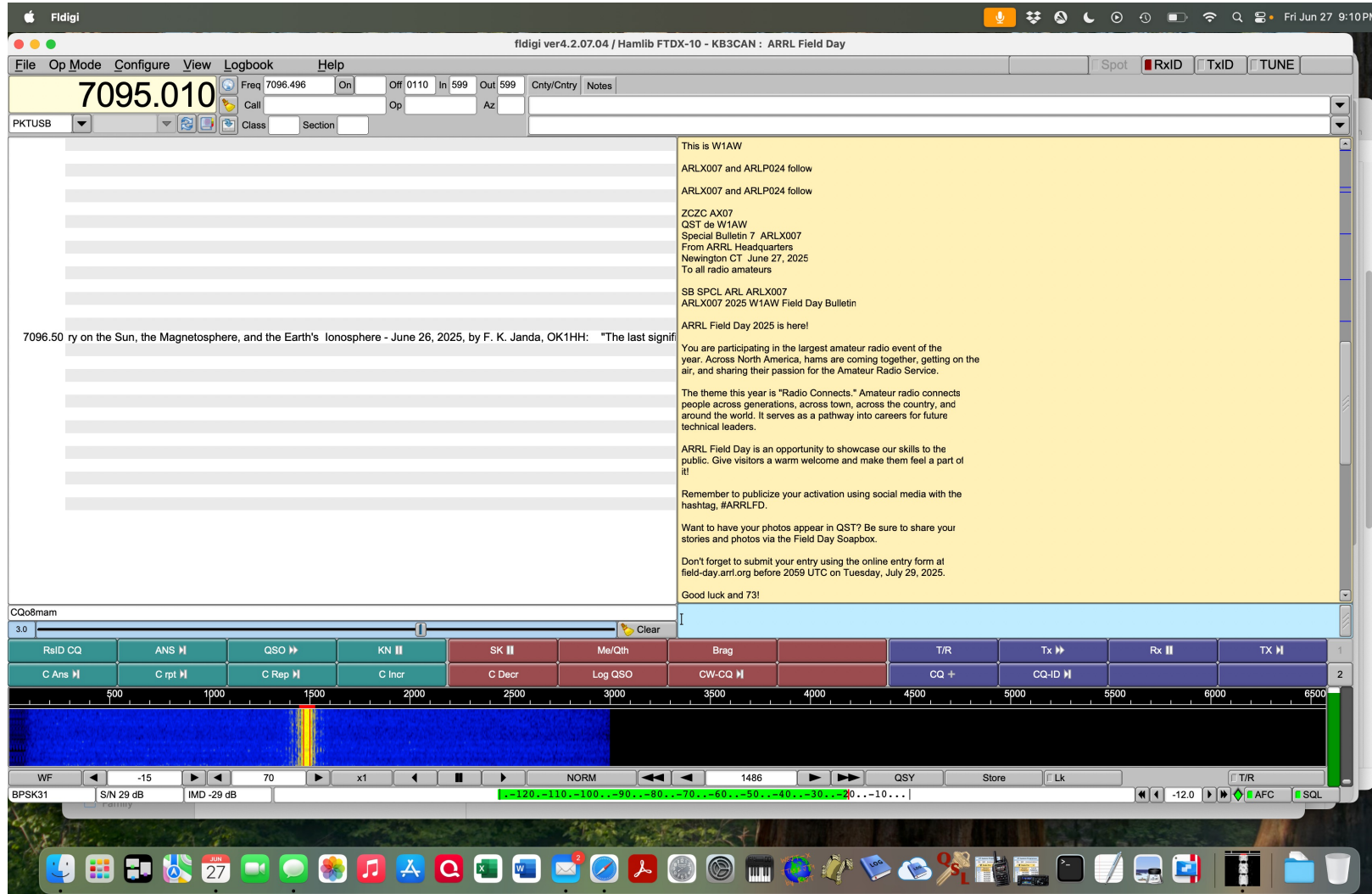
Cabrillo log files are not required for Field Day. The .dup file is the only log file this software creates that ARRL requires you to submit for Field Day.

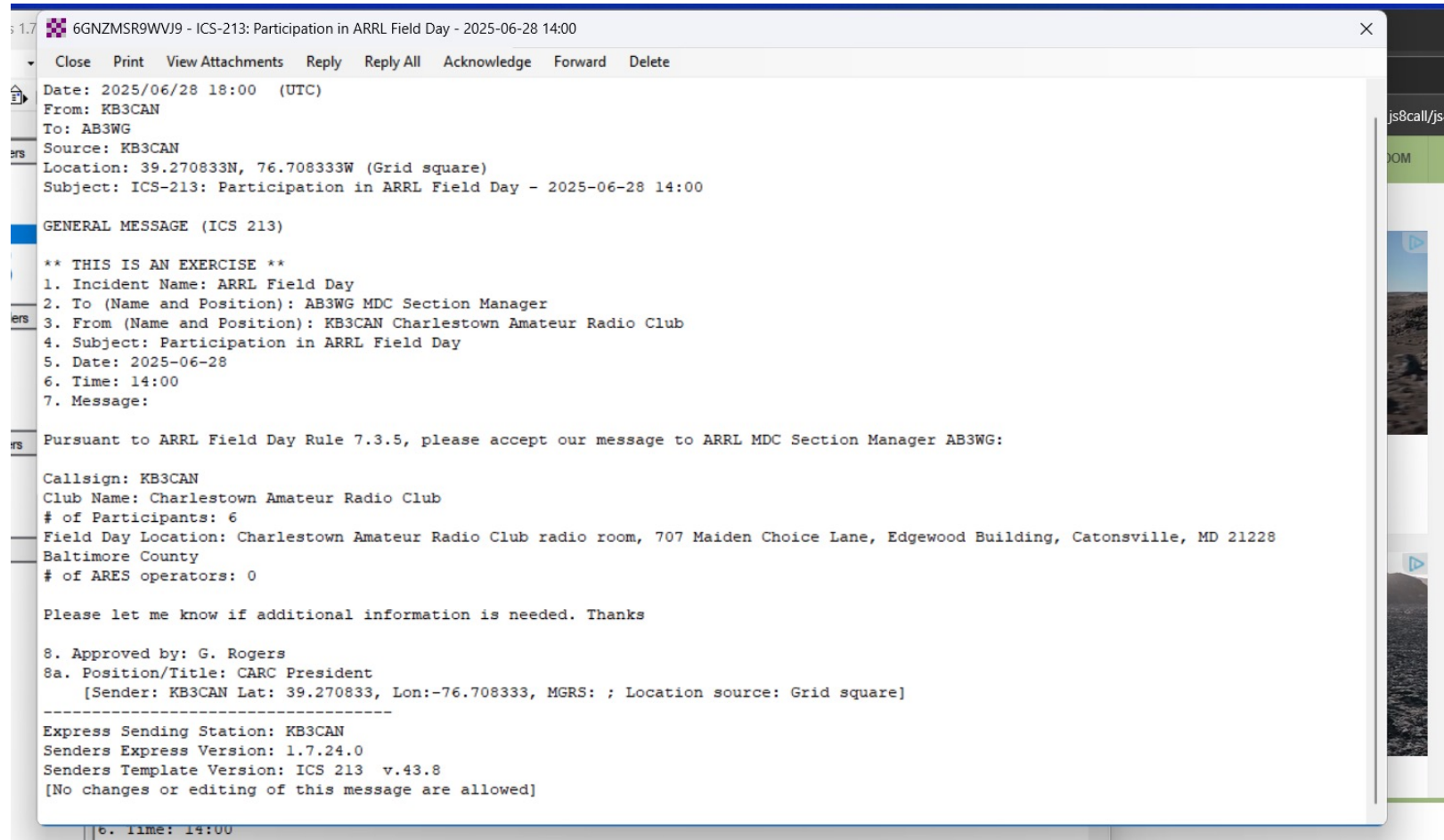

ARRL Field Day 2025 - Score

- 255 digital QSOs x 2 = 510 points
- 21 phone QSOs x 1 = 21 points
- 531 QSO points x 2 power multiplier = claimed score 1062 points
- 100 bonus points for copying W1AW Field Day Message
- 100 bonus points for sending Winlink message to AB3WG MDC Section Manager
- 100 bonus points for advertising via social media (My Erickson & CCI-Charlestown.org)
- 50 bonus points for submitting via web

ARRL Field Day 2025 - Score

Total Score = 1412

For comparison, 2024 West Carroll Group score was 3362, three operators working CW, digital, phone for about 19 hours
