Acceptable items for pick-up by **volunteers**: (Residents call **601-8124 landline**, otherwise **410-737-8838 x8124#**)

- CLEAN, gently used clothing
- Jewelry
- Purses, shoes & leather goods
- Hats, gloves & scarves
- Linens & towels, etc.
- Small rugs
- Cooking utensils, pots & pans, dishes, & glassware
- Silk flowers/ flower arrangements/ wreaths (**NO clear glass commercial vases**)
- Knick knacks
- Picture frames, pictures no larger than 2' x 2'; larger go to Furniture
- Collectible items, hobby/crafts/toys/games/puzzles
- Seasonal decorations
- Unused stationary and greeting cards
- Books, audiobooks, CDs (not self-recorded), DVDs (NO cassettes/videocassettes)
- DVD players
- Small lamps up to 26"; larger go to Furniture
- Small electrical appliances & phones IN WORKING ORDER
- Computers/laptops/tablets no older than 3 yrs.
- Small medical items such as canes, grabbers, Depends, etc.

FURNITURE: Treasure Sale Furniture Director, resident Howie Nixon must approve all furniture before it is accepted as a donation. It must be in good (working, if relevant) condition.

- Smart flat screen TVs [w/ HDMI ports]. Please make sure remotes are w/ TVs.
- **Gently used** furniture sofa <72", chairs, tables, bedroom furniture, bookcases, etc.
- Pictures larger than 2' x 2'
- Lamps larger than 26" and floor lamps
- Standard size ironing boards
- Wheelchairs, transport chairs, shower stools, potty chairs (new only)

Items **NOT** accepted for pickups by volunteers:

- Walkers, rollators. EMVs have donor contact Pastoral Care about taking these items
- Household items/clothing/furniture that is stained, soiled, broken, and/or in poor condition
- Used panties/underwear/stockings; bed pillows
- Toilet raisers; used potty chairs
- Records (except Rock 'n' Roll), tape cassettes/videocassettes or cassette players
- Sofa beds, mattresses/box springs/metal bed frames or head/footboards
- Rugs
