
Travelling to North Africa: From Delacroix to Paul Klee

Course Description: The taste for the exotic and travelling to North Africa was considered in the nineteenth century as essential for the development of new artistic experiences. Eugene Delacroix will be one of the pioneers to travel to Morocco which became the birthplace of Orientalism. He spent six months travelling as part of a diplomatic mission led by Count Charles de Mornay. He compiled seven sketchbooks recording the people, the sights, colors and sounds of Morocco. Other artists followed in his footsteps such as Matisse, Kandinsky, Gabriel Munter, Paul Klee and August Macke.

These artists explored the markets, the Islamic architecture and landscapes and their experiences will be a revelation in the exploration of color and its abstract qualities. They will transform the light of North Africa into a new pictorial language.

The course is rich in images that will invite questions and discussion.
