

At Charlestown United Protestant Church we seek to be a family. It is our desire to **Reach out with the God's love** as His ambassadors to a broken and hurting world.

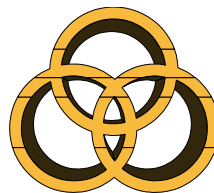

How to become a member?

If you desire to become a member of Charlestown United Protestant Church, you do so in the following ways:

- *Letter of transfer* from another church where you were an active communing member prior to moving to Charlestown;
- *Reaffirmation of faith* for persons whose membership in another church has lapsed and they want to renew their Christian vows;
- *Profession of faith and Christian baptism* into the visible Body of the Lord Jesus Christ.

There are two kinds of membership from which you may choose:

- *Full Membership* entitles you to all the rights and privileges of our church.
- *Affiliate Membership* is for those persons who wish to retain membership in their former church. At the same time, they will enjoy all the rights and privileges as a member of our church. (This status of membership is only available to Charlestown residents.)
- *Associate Membership* (Resides off Campus)
